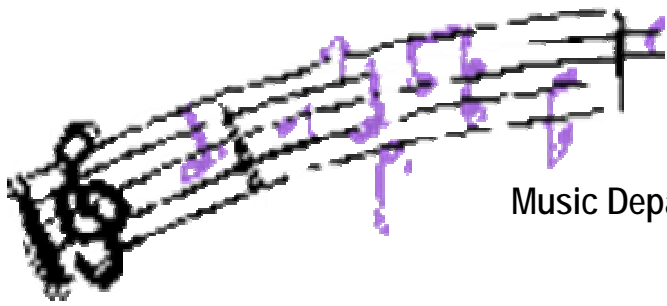
* **Swimming** – we enter competent 'Club' swimmers in the 3 Ulster Schools' Competitions.

* **Cross Country Club** will take place Nov – January (Day & Staff to be confirmed)

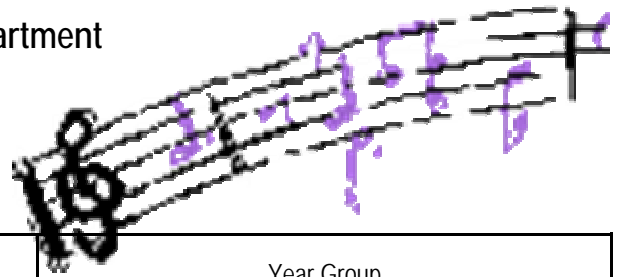
* **Golfers** (ILGU handicaps of 35 or under) will be entered in the Schoolgirls Competition in March.
