Identifying the right career, course or training route, often called the 'career planning cycle', helps you focus on what you should do when you start a new career, change your career or progress in your current career.



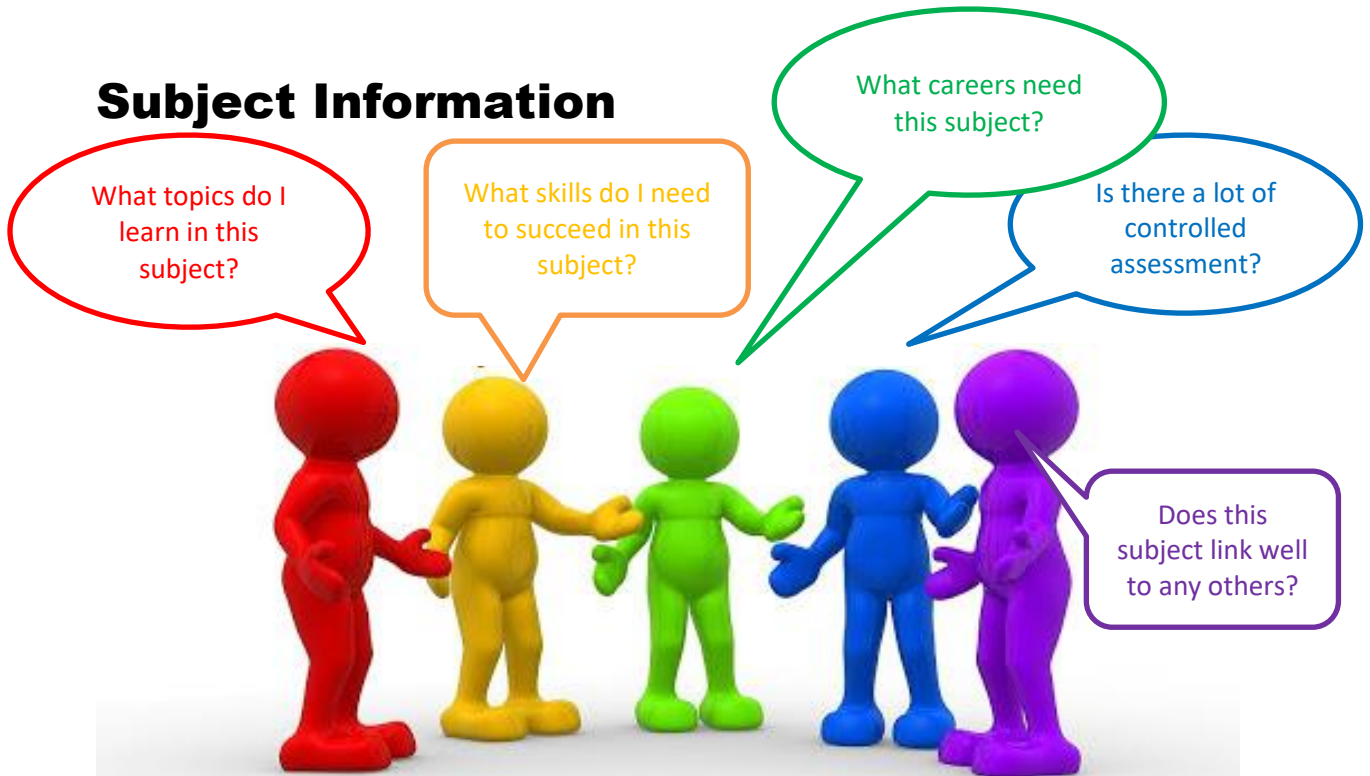

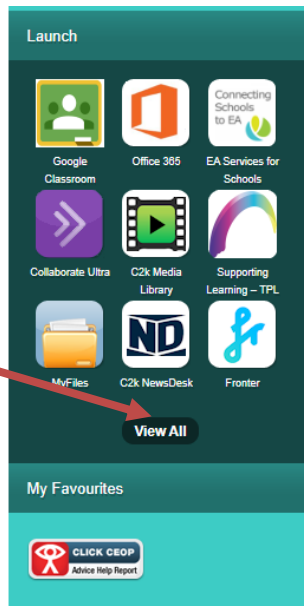

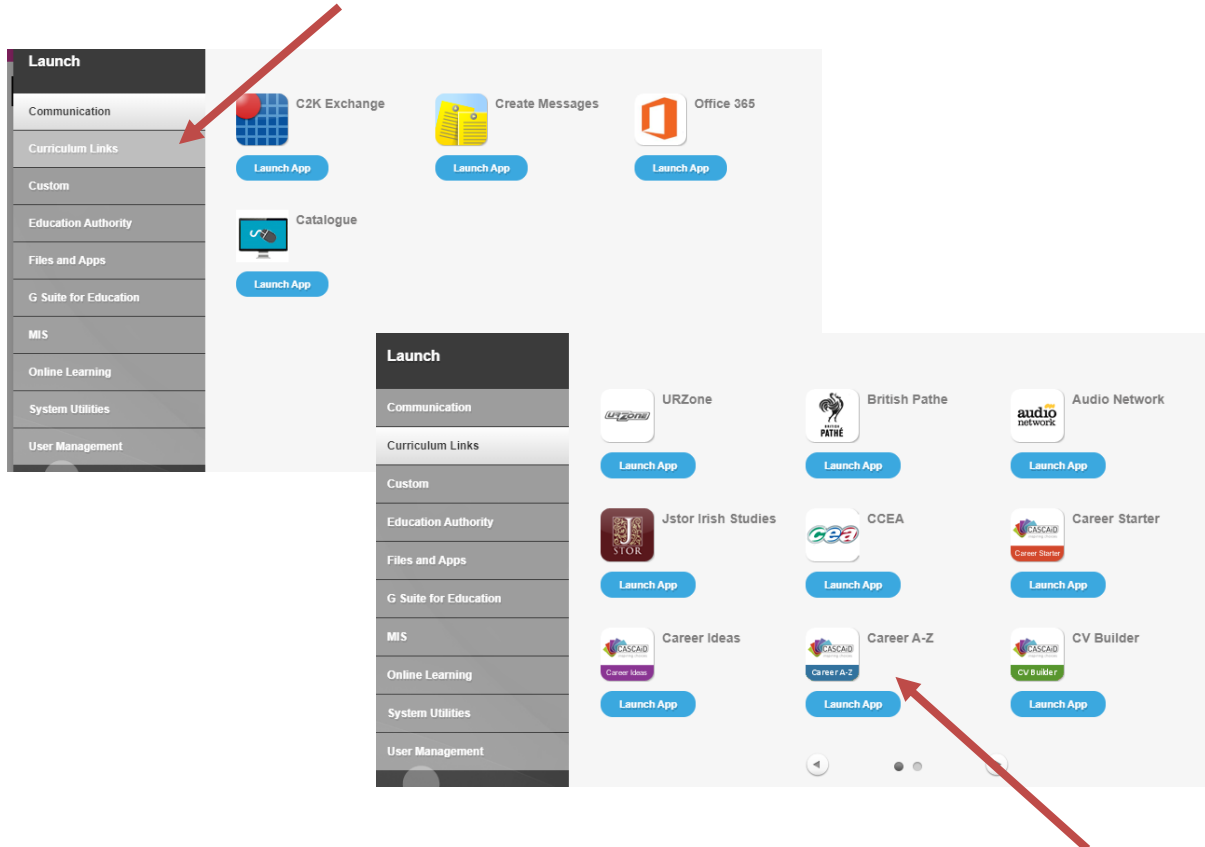
Career research - ICT Lesson
